The Food Basket Program 2024

Every year, around Christmas time, Post 290 engages the Stafford community by providing holiday meals for families. This year was no exception. Every year Stafford County Social Services registers more and more families to receive food boxes for the holidays. This year, Post 290 provided meals for 531 mouths through our Holiday Food Basket Program. This historic program is fulfilling a vital need to support members of our community experiencing food insecurities.

The Food Basket Program is active for most of the year prior to December. Once schools resume instruction in the Fall, liaison work begins to gather support from the county's schools to host collection boxes for food items. Early in November (Nov 4 this year) the Program kicks into high gear with the distribution of cardboard boxes to the schools who earlier have agreed to support the program. The boxes are filled with donations by the students and collected (Dec 9 this year) to the Post 290 Annex where their contents are inventoried and sorted (Dec 10-13) into smaller boxes each of which contain the supplies to provide a meal for the whole family. Distribution took place on Dec 13 and 14. Recipients are referred to Post 290 by Stafford Head Start & Stafford County Social Services. S.E.R.V.E. picked up the glass, expired, and extra food that was not picked up by families. Nothing is allowed to go to waste.

Of course no project of this size can be attempted without the support of volunteers and Post 290 wants to thank them all. Leading the charge was BJ Payne. Supporting volunteers included members of Post 290, (Auxiliary, American Legion Riders) Venture Crew 84, Post 290 Bombers, Junior Shooters, Stafford County Sheriff's Office Cadet Program, Mountain View HS (Learn & Serve, NHS, JROTC), Stafford HS (HOSA, Learn & Serve, NHS), Fredericksburg Christian School, Stafford Middle, Dixon Smith (NJHS), Surgeon Lawrence Brooke Society, C.A.R., and many other volunteers from the community. They packed 373 boxes for 531 adults, children, and babies in need.

Greetings SAL members and your families! I hope everyone is well and safe. Members can login into their myLegion.org account and renew directly or via the quick renew website: legion.org/SAL-Renew.

The procedure for modifying the current dues in the system is the submission of a Squadron Data Report (SDR) that is available at the Sons of The American Legion website under Publications and Forms. The SDR should be sent to the detachment and the email address Post and Squadron Reports (postsqdnupdates@legion.org) for processing.
